Before registration, you must make a valid Email ID and before submitting your registration, you must upload your photo (JPEG file) and signature (JPEG file), then you fill up the online registration form and submit. When you submit the online fill-up registration form, then you will get an e-payment option. Thereafter, pay the application fees by net banking, credit card, debit card, UPI payment etc... When your registration fee of Rs: 500/- (Non-refundable amount Five hundred rupees) for all category student is paid, then you will get a conformation e-mail of "Online registration details" and e-payment receipt in your registered email id, at inbox or spam folder, and then you print two copies of 'Online registration details and e-payment receipt'.

All India Entrance Examination for Admission (Computer Based Test): This exam will be of total 100 marks. The subjects are English, General Knowledge, General Intelligence, Current Affairs and Math. Each subject carries 20 marks for questions. One mark will be deducted for each wrong answer. To pass the first level of the entrance exam, the candidate must obtain at least 60 percent marks in each subject and 60 percent or more in total	Qualify/ Disqualify
Personality Test (Computer Based Test): This exam will be of total 100 marks. The subjects are Psychology and Reasoning. Each subject carries 50 marks for questions. One mark will be deducted for each wrong answer. To pass the second level of the Personality Test, the candidate must obtain at least 60 percent marks in each subject and 60 percent or more in total.	Qualify/ Disqualify
Medical Test: (if applicable) Medical tests are conducted everywhere by departmental medical examiners.	Fit/Unfit
