SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE CANDIDATES

- Candidates should read the e-admit card carefully.
- Under no circumstances admission will be allowed without the valid e-admit card downloaded from the authority's website.
- Candidate must carry an original photo identity card having the date of birth as printed on the e-admit card.
- If original photo identity card does not have the date of birth then the candidate must carry an additional original certificate in proof of their date of birth.
- In case of mismatch in the date of birth mentioned in the e-admit card and original photo id/the certificate brought in support of date of birth, the candidate will not be allowed to appear in the examination.
- Candidates will not be allowed entry after entry closing time on any ground.
- Candidates should reach the examination venue 1 (one) hour before and enter the examination hall at least 30 (thirty) minutes before commencement of the examination.
- Pen and paper for rough work shall be provided in the examination lab.
- Electronic watch (timer) will be available on the computer screen allotted to candidates.
- Prohibited items such as watches, books, pens, paper chits, magazines, electric gadgets (mobile phone, bluetooth devices, head phones, pen/buttonhole cameras, scanner, calculator, storage devices etc) are strictly not allowed in the examination lab. If any such item is found in the possession of a candidate in the examination lab, his/her candidature liable to be cancelled and legal/criminal proceedings could be initiated against him/her.
- It is reiterated that candidates should not bring bags and prohibited items as mentioned above to the examination venue, In case they bring any such item, they would have to make their own arrangements for safe custody of such items. The Commission shall neither make any arrangement nor be responsible for the safe custody of any such item.
- Candidate must ensure that they do not appear in online exam more than once, otherwise candidature of such candidate would be cancelled and they would be debarred from future examinations.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE CANDIDATES

1. All Exam Labs are under Video Surveillance.
2. The candidates are advised to avoid talking to other candidates or indulging in any unfair means
3. Candidates must strictly abide by the instructions given by the exam functionaries (Centre Supervisor/Invigilator, etc).
4. The candidates should ensure that they provide clear Left Thumb Impression (LTI), Certification Statement in their running handwriting and signature on Commission's copy of Admit Card.
5. No candidate is allowed to leave the examination lab before the completion of the examination for any reason without permission from the exam functionaries. Once a candidate leaves the lab without the permission of the exam functionaries, he/she shall not be allowed to re-enter the examination lab and shall be debarred from the examination.
6. If any candidate is found obstructing the conduct of the examination or creating disturbances at the examination venue, his/her candidature shall be summarily cancelled. Such candidate shall also be liable to be debarred from future examinations of the Authority and legal/criminal proceedings could be initiated against him/her.
7. If the examination does not commence at the scheduled time or is interrupted midway due to any technical snag or for any other reason, candidates should follow the instructions of the exam functionaries. They may have to wait patiently till the issue is suitably addressed and resolved. In case, the problem is major and cannot be resolved for any reason, their examination may be rescheduled for which the candidates would be duly intimated.
8. Candidates are assured that in case of any disruption of examination for any reason such as any major/minor technical snag or slow speed of server/breakdown of server etc., they will not, under any circumstances, lose the examination time to which they are entitled.
9. Candidates are advised to send a email to the concerned Authority, in case they notice any irregularity during conduct of examination. The identity of such candidates will be kept confidential.
10. In case of any doubt or any clarification, the candidates are advised to contact the helpline numbers/e-mail as indicated at top of page 1 of the Admission Certificate.
11. Candidates are advised to visit the exam venue at least one day in advance so that they can reach the examination venue on the date of exam in time.

INSTRUCTIONS TO BE FOLLOWED DURING THE EXAMINATION

1. On the Computer Screen available in front of you, you are required to type your Roll Number & PASSWORD as indicated in your Admit Card.
2. Please read the Instruction Sheet carefully, then click on "I HAVE READ THE INSTRUCTIONS AND UNDERTAKE TO ABIDE BY THE SAME"
3. You are advised not to touch the wires and cables as it could lead to the computer shutting down.
4. In case you face any technical issue while logging into the examination or at any time during the examination, please contact the Invigilator immediately to address the issue.
5. The Question Paper consists of objective type multiple choice questions with 4 options out of which only 1 is correct.
6. The computer based exam will be Monolingual. Questions and Answer options will appear in only English languages.
7. There is a TIMER (Clock) available on the TOP RIGHT HAND CORNER of the Screen which shows the time remaining for the completion of the exam.
8. Every correct answer will get 1 mark and 1 marks will be deducted for each wrong answer. No marks will be deducted for unanswered questions.
9. Only one question will be displayed on the computer screen at a time. To attempt next question the candidates should click on "Next Question" or Previous Question to go "back" click on button provided at the bottom of the screen.
10. Questions can be answered in any order within the given time. The candidate should click on the correct choice from 4 options given. In case the candidate does not wish to attempt any question, it can be left blank.
11. The candidate can change the option of a question later by selecting a new option in case he/she wishes to. In case candidate does not want to answer the question, he/she can deselect the answer by clicking Erase provided against the question.
12. To move back and forth between questions, candidates should use the Next Question OR < Previous Question button or click on the question number displayed at the right side of the computer screen where question number would be displayed along with "ATTEMPTED" or "NOT ATTEMPTED" status.
13. The answers will be saved whenever the candidate goes to the next question, by clicking on Next Question > OR <Previous Question button.
14. On the completion of the test duration, even if the candidate does not attempt any question or does not click on the Preview Submit button, a NIL result will be saved automatically by the computer.
15. Candidates will only be able to submit the test on completion of the stipulated time. Otherwise also, the system will automatically submit the test on its own on completion of the stipulated time.
